### Avon Community Center April 20th City Meeting

The open forum meeting for the community center was held Monday April 20th at the Avon City Hall to a packed house. A powerpoint was presented by Cheri that showed interest in a community center since 1996. Dan Zimmerman handed out a sheet with a summary of items that had been presented at previous meetings. Father Edward presented what the St. Benedict's parish hoped to accomplish in donating the school and surrounding property to the city. It was then opened up to the public to ask questions. The main concern was should the city own the school and land. Several comments were made in favor such as the Food Shelf, Montessori School and Just For Kick's group. Most of the comments were in favor of having the city own the site. There were concerns about future upkeep, taxes and additional work for the city. The city council will meet in two weeks to make a final decision.
